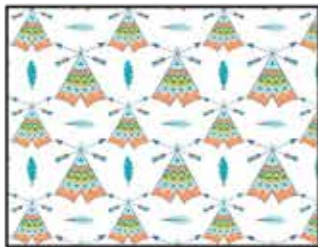

## Cutting

### Cutting Instructions

*Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.*

WOF= Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric

*Pink Version fabrics are listed second where they differ from Blue Version fabrics.*

#### **Fabric A (4300P-11 Boho 36" Panel – Blue) (4300P-22 Boho 36" Panel – Pink), cut:**

- Fussy cut (1) 35" x 42 ½" panel.

#### **Fabric B (1351-Lava Just Color! – Lava), cut:**

- (2) 2" x 42 ½" WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (2) 2" x 38" WOF strips.
- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 2 ½" x 6 ½" strips and (12) 1 ½" x 6 ½" strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 63 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 50 ½" strips.
- (12) Template 1 triangles.
- (12) Template 3 triangles.

#### **Fabric C (4301-11 Boho Motifs Tossed – Blue) (4301-44 Boho Motifs Tossed – Yellow), cut:**

- (3) Template 2 triangles.

#### **Fabric D (4302-1 Tee Pees – White/Blue) (4302-2 Tee Pees – White/Pink), cut:**

- (3) Template 2 triangles.

#### **Fabric E (4304-11 Feathers – Blue) (4304-22 Feathers – Pink), cut:**

- (3) Template 2 triangles.

#### **Fabric F (4306-1 Dream Catchers – White/Blue) (4306-2 Dream Catchers – White/Pink), cut:**

- (3) Template 2 triangles.

#### **Fabric G (4303-11 Novelty Stripe – Blue/Green) (4303-22 Novelty Stripe – Pink/Aqua), cut:**

- (2) 10" x 48 ½" LOF strips.

#### **Fabric H (1351-Grass Just Color! – Grass) (1351-Daffodil Just Color! – Daffodil), cut:**

- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### **Backing (4305-77 Elephants – Dark Blue) (4305-11 Elephants – Aqua), cut:**

- (2) 73" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 58" x 73" to make the back.

## Sewing

Sew using a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.

### Block Assembly

1. Sew (1)  $2'' \times 42\frac{1}{2}''$  Fabric B strip to each side of the  $35'' \times 42\frac{1}{2}''$  Fabric A panel. Sew (1)  $2'' \times 38''$  Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure  $36\frac{1}{2}'' \times 44\frac{1}{2}''$  to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).

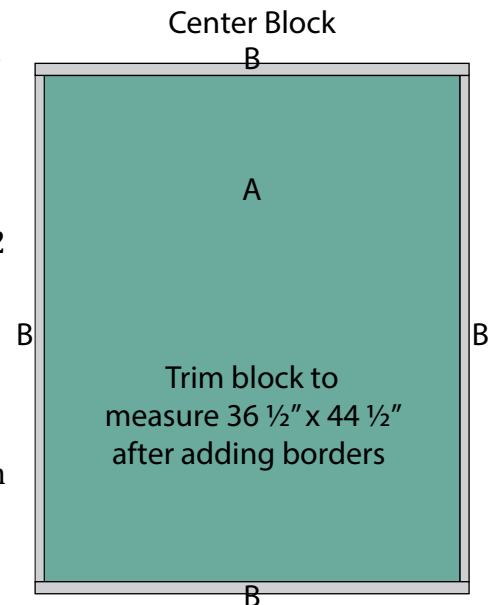

2. Place (1) Fabric B-Template 1 triangle on top of (1) Fabric C-Template 2 triangle, right sides together, aligning the left sides (Fig. 2). Sew the (2) triangles together along the left side. Press the smaller triangle open.

3. Place (1) Fabric B-Template 3 triangle on top of the Fabric C-Template 2 triangle, right sides together, aligning the right sides (Fig. 3). Sew the (2) triangles together along the right side. Press the smaller triangle open. Trim the block to measure  $6\frac{1}{2}''$  square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 4).

4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (3) Block One squares total.

5. Repeat Steps 2-3 using (3) Fabric B-Template 1 triangles, (3) Fabric D-Template 2 triangles and (3) Fabric B-Template 3 triangles to make (3)  $6\frac{1}{2}''$  Block Two squares (Fig. 5).

6. Repeat Steps 2-3 using (3) Fabric B-Template 1 triangles, (3) Fabric E-Template 2 triangles and (3) Fabric B-Template 3 triangles to make (3)  $6\frac{1}{2}''$  Block Three squares (Fig. 6).

7. Repeat Steps 2-3 using (3) Fabric B-Template 1 triangles, (3) Fabric F-Template 2 triangles and (3) Fabric B-Template 3 triangles to make (3)  $6\frac{1}{2}''$  Block Four squares (Fig. 7).

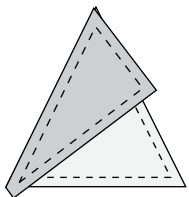

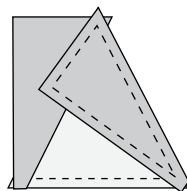

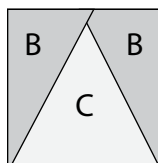

make 3

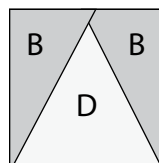

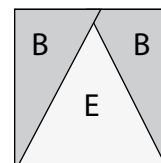

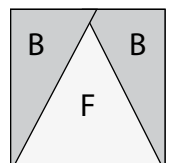

### Quilt Top Assembly

*(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)*

8. Sew together (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$  Fabric B strip, (1) Block One square, (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$  Fabric B strip, (1) Block Two square, (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$  Fabric B strip, (1) Block Three square, (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$  Fabric B strip, (1) Block Four square, (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$  Fabric B strip, (1) Block One square, (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$  Fabric B strip, (1) Block Two square and (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$  Fabric B strip in that order to make the Left Side Strip. Sew the strip to the left side of the Center Block.

9. Sew together (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$  Fabric B strip, (1) Block Three square, (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$  Fabric B strip, (1) Block Four square, (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$  Fabric B strip, (1) Block One square, (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$  Fabric B strip, (1)

Block Two square, (1) 1 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric B strip, (1) Block Three square, (1) 1 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric B strip, (1) Block Four square and (1) 1 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric B strip in that order to make the Right Side Strip. Sew the strip to the right side of the Center Block.

10. Sew (1) 10" x 48 ½" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

11. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 63 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 50 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

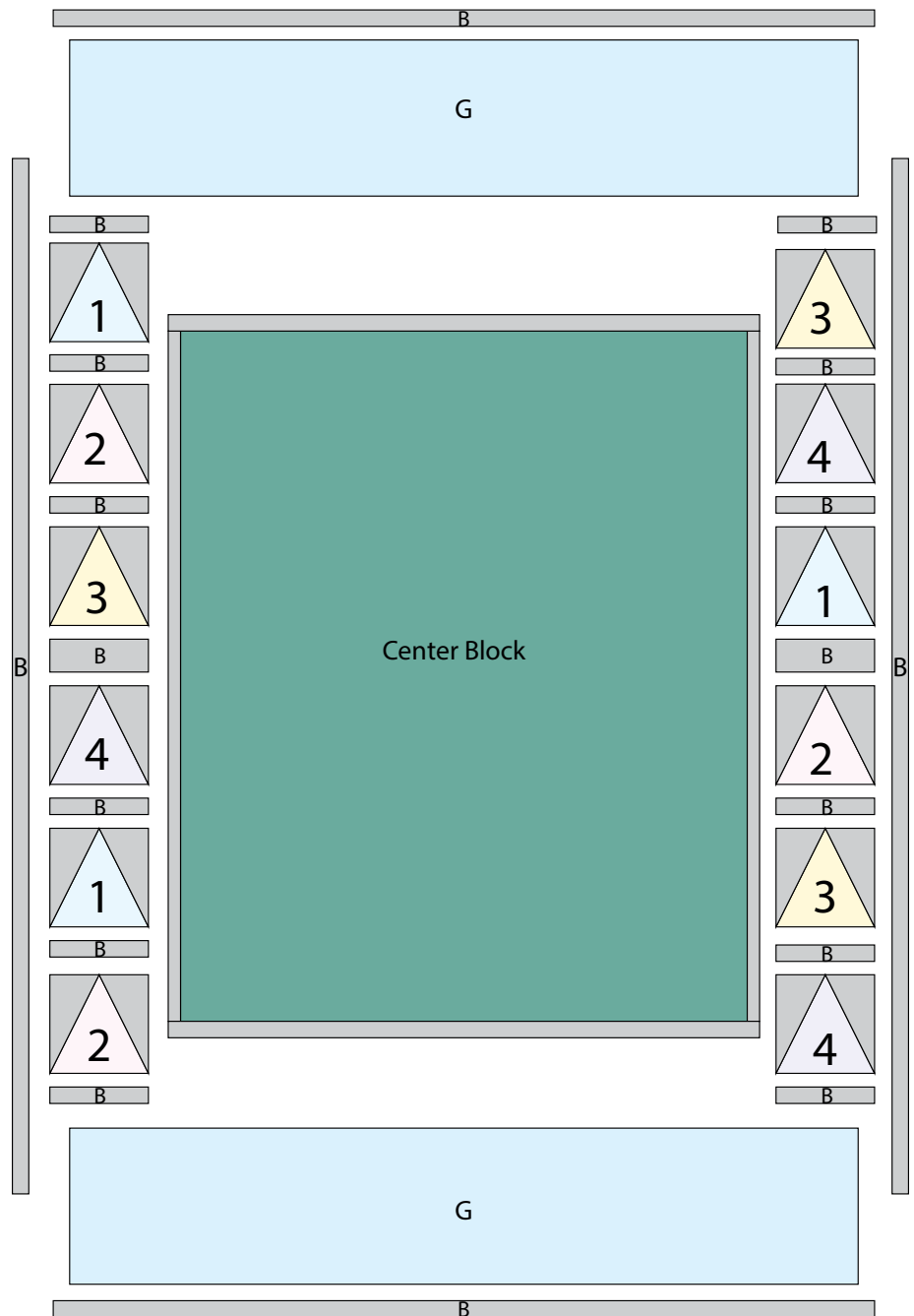
### Layering, Quilting and Finishing

12. Press the quilt top and 58" x 73" backing well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, pressed quilt top (right side up) and baste. Quilt as desired and trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.

### Binding

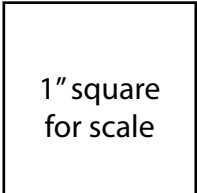
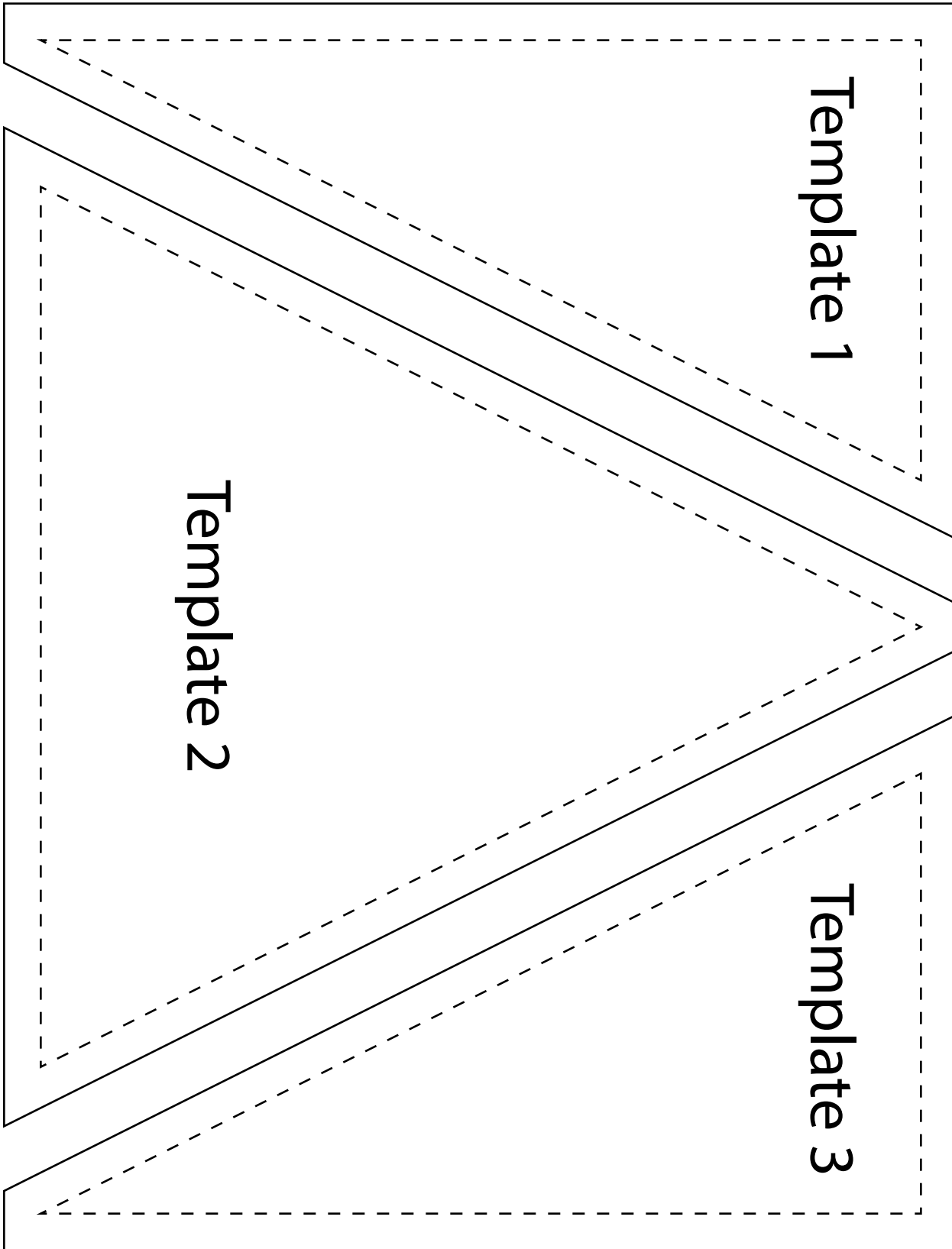
13. Cut the ends of the (6) Fabric H binding strips at a 45-degree angle and sew end to end to make (1) continuous piece of binding. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together.

14. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.
