Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted. Map Version fabrics are listed second in () where they differ from Motorcycle Version fabrics.

From the 24" Motorcycle Panel - Gray (24" USA Panel - Gray) (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 23" x 43" panel.

From the Urban Legend - Charcoal (B), cut:

- (2) 3" x 23" WOF strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 48" strips.
- (2) 1 1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (4) 1 1/2" x 17" strips.
- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 46 1/2" strips.

From the Signs - Black (C), cut:

- (2) 5" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 5" squares.

From the Fusion Illusion - Indigo (D), cut:

- (4) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 1" x 5" strips.
- (5) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 1" x 6" strips.
- (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the License Plates - Green (E) cut:

- (1) 5" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 5" squares.
- (1) 5" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 5" x 10 1/2" strips.

From the Urban Legend - Red (F), cut:

- (3) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 1" x 6" strips.
- (3) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 1" x 5" strips.
- (2) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 1" x 11 1/2" strips.

From the State Names - Black (G), cut:

- (2) 6 3/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 6 3/8" squares.

From the Map - Gray (H), cut:

- (2) 6 3/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 6 3/8" squares.

From the Motorcycles - Gray (Cars - Gray) (I), cut:

- (4) 6" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 6" x 60" strips.
- (3) 6" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 6" x 46 1/2" strips.

From the State Names - Black (Backing), cut:

- (2) 65" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 65" x 79" back.

Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) 3" x 23" Fabric B strip to each side of the 23" x 43" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2" x 48" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure 46 1/2" x 25" to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).

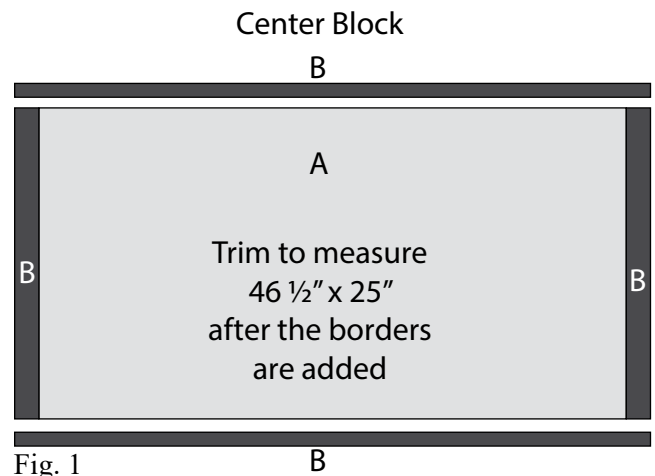

2. Sew (1) 1" x 5" Fabric D strip to each side of (1) 5" Fabric C square. Sew (1) 1" x 6" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric C square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (16) Block One squares total.

Block One make 16

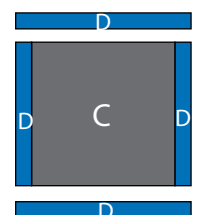

3. Sew (1) 1" x 5" Fabric F strip to each side of (1) 5" Fabric E square. Sew (1) 1" x 6" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric E square to make (1) Block Two square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (8) Block Two squares total.

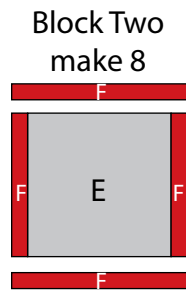

4. Sew (1) 1" x 5" Fabric F strip to each side of (1) 5" x 10 1/2" Fabric E strip. Sew (1) 1" x 11 1/2" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric E strip to make (1) Block Three rectangle (Fig. 4). Repeat to make a second Block Three rectangle.

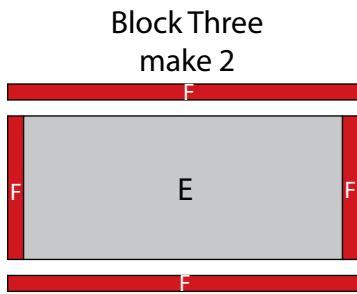

5. Place (1) 6 3/8" Fabric H square on top of (1) 6 3/8" Fabric G square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 5). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 5). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 6) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the blocks to measure 6" square to make (2) Block Four squares (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (24) Block Four squares total.

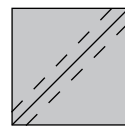

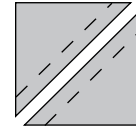

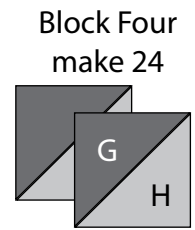

6. Follow Figure 8 and sew together (4) Block Two squares, (12) Block Four squares, (6) Block One squares, (1) Block Three rectangle and (2) 1 1/2" x 17" Fabric B strips to make the Top Section.

7. Follow Figure 9 and sew together (6) Block One squares, (12) Block Four squares, (4) Block Two squares, (1) Block Three rectangle and (2) 1 1/2" x 17" Fabric B strips to make the Bottom Section.

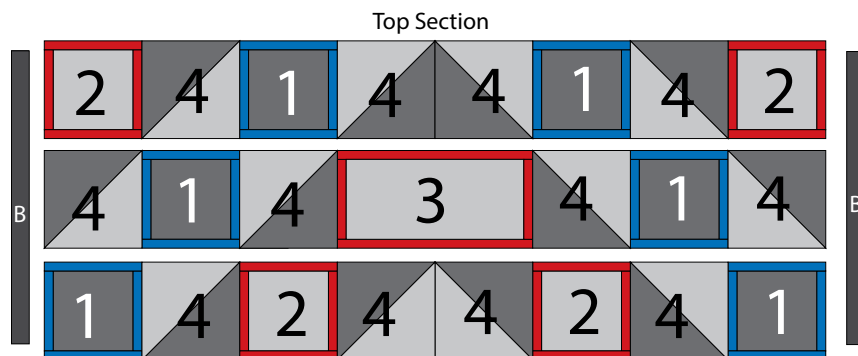

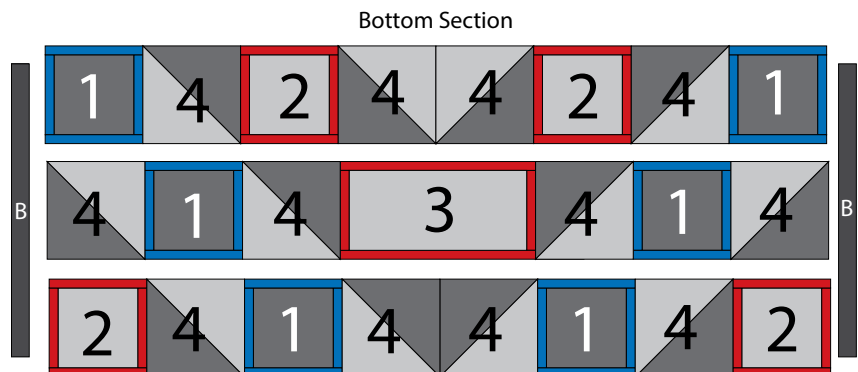

Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

8. Sew the Top Section to the top of the Center Block. Sew the Bottom Section to the bottom of the Center Block.

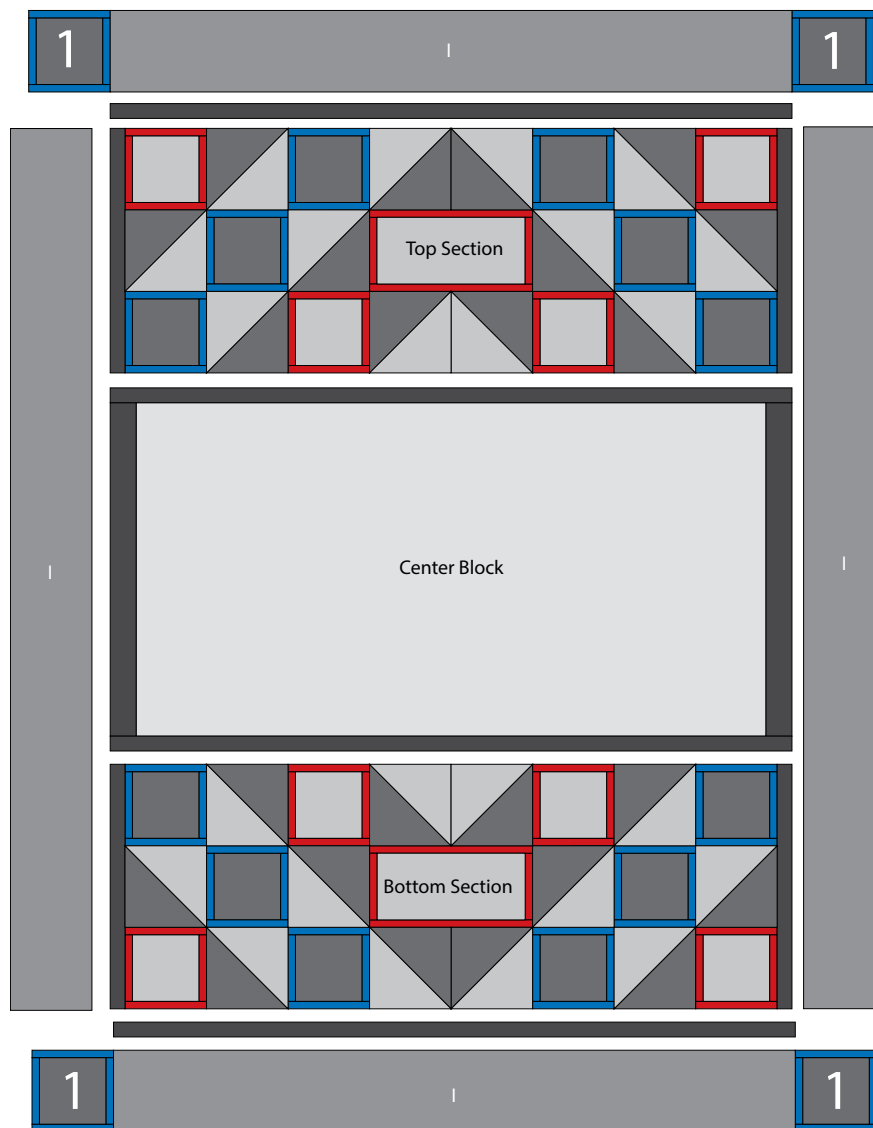
9. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 46 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

10. Sew (1) 6" x 60" Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) Block One square to each end of (1) 6" x 46 ½" Fabric I strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

11. Layer and quilt as desired.

12. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric D strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

13. Bind as desired.
